Academy ISD Employee Dress Policy

The dress and grooming of district employees affects student learning and the school climate; therefore, personal preference of clothing should not interfere with the educational process. **Clothing worn by employees should reflect or exceed the expectations set for the student dress code**. The following are the guidelines for employee dress at Academy ISD:

- 1. All employees should present a neat, clean and professional appearance.
- 2. Hair should be neatly styled. Facial hair should be trimmed and not at an excessive length.
- 3. Shirts for men must have collars. No T-Shirts. (Exception: School spirit t-shirts, worn on designated days.)
- 4. Appropriate soled footwear must be worn. No flip-flops, shower shoes or beach shoes allowed.
- 5. The wearing of denim jeans is allowed, but the jeans must not be torn, frayed or have holes of any kind.
- 6. No yoga pants allowed.
- 7. Shorts of any kind are not allowed in the classroom during school hours. This includes coaching shorts as well as those with a nice short suit. Consideration may be given for special events and field trips.
- 8. PE and Athletics teachers are expected to change and dress for class in a professional manner. However, if time does not permit, these instructors are allowed to wear dress warm-up suits that maintain a professional appearance. No cotton sweats are to be worn. (Sweats and shorts may be worn in the Gym or on the practice/game fields.)
- 9. All dresses and skirts worn by female employees shall be knee length. Skorts are considered skirts and fall under this guideline.
- 10. Employees must wear undergarments at all times.
- 11. Backless, strapless, tight-fitting, ill-fitting, or revealing clothing is not allowed
- 11. Tattoos, if any, must be covered during school hours or while attending school events.

Inappropriate dress that detracts from the educational process will be addressed on an individual basis by a district administrator.
