

6th Grade Elective Choices

Band I

Beginning band focuses on developing instrument performance fundamentals and music literacy. Students make an instrument selection based on an interview/placement process conducted by the band director, which happens in the spring semester of the student's 5th grade school year. The class concentrates on the development of note-reading skills, aural skills, rhythmic patterns, intonation, and tone production.

***Note: If your student is interested in band, he/she must start in 6th grade. Students will have multiple opportunities for additional electives in 7th and 8th grade.

Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)
