Personal Electronic Devices

Guidelines for Use in Grades EC-12

Beginning with the 2025-2026 school year, Texas House Bill 1481 requires all school districts to restrict the use of personal communication devices during the instructional day. Academy ISD will enforce a policy prohibiting the use of personal electronic devices at any time during the school day.

EXPECTATIONS:

- **Device Usage**: Cell phones, smart watches, wireless headphones, and other personal devices used to communicate electronically must be powered off during school hours.
- **Headphones**: Wireless headphones, earphones, and earbuds with bluetooth capability are not allowed to be worn on campus.
- **School Day**: Class time from the first to the last instructional period, passing periods, restroom breaks, and lunch.
- Turned Off and Stored: Powered down, out of sight, and not to be used. Inside a backpack, purse, or gym bag. <u>Carrying devices on the body is not permitted</u>
- **Restricted Areas:** Cell phones and telecommunication devices may not be used in the hallways, restrooms, locker rooms, cafeteria, or any common areas throughout the school day.

CONSEQUENCES:

Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in progressive discipline:

OFFENSE	CONSEQUENCE
1 ST OFFENSE	Device confiscated. Parent/Guardian contact.
2 ND OFFENSE	Student referred to Admin. Device confiscated. Parent/Guardian notified and required to pick up the device during the school day.
3 RD OFFENSE	Student referred to Admin. Device confiscated. Student assigned ISS. Parent/Guardian notified and required to pick up the device during the school day.
4 [™] OFFENSE	Student referred to Admin. Device confiscated. Student assigned ISS. Parent/Guardian notified and required to pick up the device during the school day.
5 [™] OFFENSE	Student referred to Admin. Device confiscated. Student assigned ISS days and placed on campus probation. In-person meeting with Parent/Guardian to pick up the device during the school day.
6 [™] OFFENSE	Student referred to Admin. Device confiscated. Student assigned ISS days and placed on campus probation. Campus Level Conference with recommendation for placement in DAEP.

EXCEPTIONS:

• **Emergencies or Drills**: During emergencies or drills, students may carry their backpack, bag, or purse, ensuring access to their cell phone for emergencies.

UNCLAIMED DEVICES:

Devices not collected within 90 days may be considered abandoned and are subject to disposal.

AISD COMMUNICATIONS

 In the event of an emergency, AISD will communicate with updated information through email, text message, the district webpage, and/or social media.
