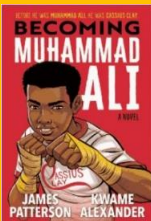

Poetry Books



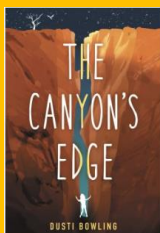
Becoming Muhammad Ali
